INSANE, INHERITS \$10,000.

Indigent Since 1898, Patient Can Now Repay Hospital.

The Essex County, N. J., Board of Freeholders were informed yesterday that Edward Clement, an indigent patient at the Essex County Hospital for the Insane at Overbrook since March

4, 1898, had fallen heir to \$10,000.

County Attorney Taylor, after discussing the case with the attorney for the estate from which Clement will inherit the money as to the best way of taking care of it, said it was decided to invest the money and from the income to pay two years' board every year for Clements, and in this way repay what the county had paid out to keep him. It has cost \$5 a week to keep Clement for the twenty-two years he has been in the institution.
