

Insane Man Killed by Auto.

MONTCLAIR, N. J., Aug. 26.—Albert Barnett, 60 years old, an inmate of the Overbrook Insane Asylum, stepped in front of an automobile on the Pompton Turnpike, near Cedar Grove, last night. He died in the Mountainside Hospital an hour later. The car was in charge of Elmer B. Taylor, who was held for the Grand Jury. Besides Taylor the other occupants of the car included William Greenfield, Miss Helen Greenfield, and John Ingraham, all of New York. Barnett had been an inmate of the asylum for thirty years.
