

# WANT OFFICIALS REMOVED.

## Freeholders Report "Dereliction" in Overbrook Hospital Work.

As the result of an investigation of a contract for a sewage disposal plant at Overbrook Hospital, N. J., a sub-committee of the Essex County Board of Freeholders yesterday recommended that the Freeholders demand the resignations of County Engineer Frederic A. Reimer, County Counsel Charles C. Pilgrim, and County Attorney Herbert W. Taylor for "gross dereliction of duty."

The committee also recommended that suit be brought against the contractor for alleged overpayments on the disposal plant, and that the rest of the work be taken from him and done by prisoners at the county penitentiary.
